



Models 3101 and 3201 are Disk Bedders for 25 to 50 PTO-HP tractors that can bite into the best bed shaping practices on a small-farm scale. "Junior" Model 1701 is scaled down for narrower tractors and row systems. The simple, rugged design is most durable, even in rocky soil.



**Bed Shaping 101**

The single-toolbar 3101 is basic. With little practice, operators can quickly gauge cutting depth with the tractor hitch. Bed height depends on depth of cut. The double-toolbar 3201 features gauge wheels for drop-and-go depth control.

The 2nd toolbar and gauge wheels can be valuable to set-up other equipment. Multi-Tool Kits are available to set-up a Chisel Plow, Ripper or Bed Lifter.

**Models 3101 and 3201**

- 50 PTO-HP rating
- Category-1 or 2 hitch
- Four 22" disks on two gangs
- Model 3101 features a single 3" square toolbar, 84" wide
- Model 3201 features double 3" square toolbars, 84" wide, with gauge wheels for depth control
- Adjustable 54-72" bed C-C width

**Model 1701 has the same hitch and disk gangs**

- 3" square toolbar, 72" wide
- Four 20" disks
- Adjustable 48-60" bed C-C width

**Horsepower requirement**

If tractor drawbar can clear the bed height you want and wheel spacing straddles the bed width, it also has enough power to use in loose soil. Pull is harder if weight is added to penetrate hard ground.
