Leveling Bars

S-tine field cultivators tend to leave minor ridges between the last row of shanks. How much depends on ground speed. This simple drag-type leveling bar levels the soil, if preferred. Use alone or with a Rolling Basket.

Rolling Baskets

Rolling Baskets are popular to crumble and firm the seedbed. The 1-ft basket sections have 14" diameter and feature 3/4" round beater bars with an alternating chevron pattern, rotating on a 1-1/2" shaft. Series 782 features two bearing mounts on units up to 4-ft wide. Series 783 features three bearings mounts on units up to 8-ft wide.

If the beater bar design matters to you, we aim to please, though we find little real difference between patterns or designs, except for what looks good. Speed helps for a crushing or churning action on the surface, which can lead to consideration for Double Rolling Baskets, which are available. In the end, timing matters most. Be in the field when soil crumbles best.

Rolling Baskets may level the ground somewhat with it's firming action but it doesn't push soil around to level ridging. Adding the Leveling Bar or any kind of Harrow in front of the basket is common practice.

Floatation & Depth Control

You may be more familiar with Floating Rolling Baskets, which have been used for decades on conventional 20 or 30-ft tillage equipment. Our Rolling Baskets are rigid-mounted for 1-bed specialty equipment purposes. The weight of the machine helps with crumbling and firming and there's no need for these baskets to flex with ground contour. Also with narrower equipment, a Rolling Basket also provides depth control for the entire machine, so gauge wheels on Cultivators or Disk Bedders can be used but are not required.
