


Primary beds your way

Use disk gangs as-is for a rounded bed or add from a choice of attachments to alter bed shape and/or further condition bed top. Leveling bars grade beds to specific height with a flatter top. Then beds typically hold shape better over winter and provide the least soil disturbance with the finishing bedder before planting. Leveling pans do the same but the weight of the disk bedder can be on the pans for firmer tops.



Rolling baskets are popular for crumbling and firming soil and ideal for passing excessive residue. Shaper pans form a completed, squared and firmed bed for planting in right conditions.

Though disk bedders are intended for more-efficient and better bed conditioning with primary bedding, beds can be formed for immediate planting in very easy-working soils. Note that disk gangs turn bottom soil up on top so this is not for every soil type. Utilize one of these four attachments to define bed shape as needed. The final result is dependent on prior tillage work and/or soil type.
